CURRENT PARK & PLAY GUIDELINES

Booking a Tee Time

• Tee times can be made by booking on-line at

https://www.destinationhotels.com/squawcreek/recreation/squaw-valley-golf/lake-tahoe-golf

or by calling 530-581-6637. Thank you for leaving a message with your first and last name, date requesting to play, number of players, preferred time, and a call back number if we don't answer. Your call will be returned the same day confirming your tee time.

- Foursome will be the maximum group size
- Tee times will begin at 8am daily
- All carts must be returned by 8:00pm

• Tee times must be made in advance, no walk-ons

Prior to your Tee Time

- Park in the self-parking lot
- Walking is encouraged

• 20/30 minutes prior to your tee time, check in with a golf cart attendant and provide your name and tee time, retrieve a cart from the cart staging area (current cart staging area is in the parking lot), pick up your clubs from your car and drive around the hotel to the golf shop to check in.

- If you choose to ride, load your clubs on a single-occupancy cart
- Family members, if living together, may ride on the same cart
- All carts will be sanitized prior to and following play
- Driving range nets are available to warm up and spaced out accordingly

During your Round

- Social Distancing guidelines must be followed throughout your round
- The flagstick must remain untouched in the cup
- Temporary measures have been taken to allow for safe retrieval of your golf ball
- Self-serve on-course water will not be available Please bring your own water
- · On-course restrooms will be available and sanitized twice daily

• Trash bins have been removed from the course – Please keep trash and dispose of following your round

Food and Beverage

• Sandys Pub will provide take-out orders to be picked up at the turn. Menu and phone number is provided on cart and golfers are encouraged to call in orders on Tee #8.

Following your Round

- Take golf cart to parking lot and unload your clubs and belongings
- Remove all trash prior to returning cart including tees, scorecard, pencil, and garbage

• Return empty cart to wash bay in the parking lot after all belongings and trash have been removed from your cart.
