The organization was founded by Mr. Robinson to provide educational programs, resources, and life experiences to help children achieve their dreams. The foundation recently expanded its academic program called TEAM EXCEL, which takes place throughout the year at Varina High School and John Rolfe Middle School, to now include five grade levels from 7th grade to 11th grade. The program saw tremendous growth within their students with a 26% GPA increase and plans to expand once again next year.

Michael Robinson, born in Richmond, Virginia, was drafted in the 4th round (100th overall) by the 49ers in the 2006 NFL Draft. He played quarterback and wide receiver at Penn State University and led the team to a Big Ten Conference title and an Orange Bowl Championship title in 2005. He finished 5th in the Heisman voting that year. In addition to his career as an NFL player, Mr. Robinson is also a NFL Network analyst, businessman and philanthropist.
